

***A Brief Summary of the Current Status of Changes in Regulations and Legislation to Allow 14-Metre (45') motorhomes on Canadian Roadways***

| AB              | N                | CSA regulations apply, and to date permit only 12.5-metre RVs. A change in maximum length to 14 metres is under discussion for proposed CSA revisions, with projected enactment in the fall of 2007. No legislation or regulations specifically prohibit 14-metre units on Alberta roadways.  |
| BC              | Y                | Regulations were amended April 27, 2006 to permit 14-metre RVs.   |
| MB              | Y <sup>1</sup>   | <sup>1</sup> Regulatory amendments are in the government queue. In the meantime, a permit can be arranged by telephoning Permit Services at the Department of Transport & Govt. Services at (204) 945-3961. It only takes a few minutes of time; and the permit is good for one year.   |
| NB              | N                | As of October 2005, 14-metre RVs were not permitted on New Brunswick roadways.  |
| NL              | N?               | Regulations are up for amendment to allow 14-metre units; timeframe unknown.  |
| NS              | Y                | Regulations permitting 14-metre RVs were amended December 20, 2005.   |
| NU              | N/A;<br>see NWT. | There being no seasonal roadways in the majority of the Territory, there are no regulations regarding RV measurements. For those RVs registered in the south, NWT regulations before division (April 99) apply. Legislation is not under review yet.  |
| NWT             | Y <sup>2</sup>   | <sup>2</sup> The 25-year-old regulation package for large vehicles (over 4500 kg; including 14-metre RVs) may be rewritten in its entirety. In the interim, there are provisions to drive 14-metre RVs under a special 1-year permit. The permits expire on December 31, 2009 (the approximately 2-year window allowing for passing of legislation). | QC              | Y <sup>4</sup>   | <sup>4</sup> As of Aug07: 14 Metre RVs are authorized on Quebec roads without permit or annual authorization. The regulation is anticipated to be amended in the near future.   |
| SK              | Y <sup>5</sup>   | <sup>5</sup> With permit available from the SGI Permit Office at (306) 775-6969 for out of province enquiries and 1-800-667-7575 for in Saskatchewan calls, pending forthcoming changes in regulations.   |
