 μ - Lead trailer must be 5th wheel (AB specifies "pin & plate 5th wheel coupling mounted over the rear axle"); must have two or more tandem axles; and must be longer than following unit.
 ϵ - 5th wheel requires no safety chain. Other trailers: 2 required, crossing under the hitch and able to keep the unit substantially following the towing vehicle. Each chain must be able to tow the unit if the other fails and keep hitch off the road.
